OGF is an open community committed to driving the rapid evolution and adoption of applied distributed computing. Applied Distributed Computing is critical to developing new, innovative and scalable applications and infrastructures that are essential to productivity in the enterprise and within the science community.

OGF Membership Mission and Objectives

The OGF mission is carried out through community-initiated activity including events, workshops, and chartered groups. Using a proven open process, OGF accomplishes its work through open forums that build the community, explore trends, share best practices and consolidate these best practices into standards. It identifies relations with other communities having similar requirements to drive forward the adoption of applied distributed computing specifications that will, in turn, respond to OGF member needs;

OGF hosts several events each year to bring the community together to hold workshops, share best practices, further develop relevant specifications and use cases, and to showcase and deliver experiences.

Part of the OGF mission is to engage with organizations, enabling them to become Members in partnership with OGF and granting benefits detailed in this document. To become Members, organizations complete the member application, sign the Membership Agreement and pay the membership dues.

Each OGF membership period begins with receipt of membership payment and has a duration of 12 months.

The following packages are suitable and open to profit and non-for profit organizations. In addition, these opportunities are open and available to National, Regional and International research and development initiatives, which have a bounded duration (ie, projects versus formal organizations).

PROJECT Member

OGF Project Membership, Research & Technological Development initiative

Cost: \$1,500 Benefits:

Logo and project profile as well as dedicated, related interview over the lifetime of the project (ie how the project engages with existing specifications such as OGF OCCI or PGI etc. through the WGs). OGF Organizational Membership

Multi-Year Membership Discount

OGF Members receive a discounted membership rate when they commit to extended membership and pay for multiple years at once. A discount of 10% is applied to the annual membership rate for a two-year membership, and a discount of 15% is applied for memberships of three or more years.

Event Passes

OGF Organizational Members are eligible to purchase event passes in advance, thereby locking in a fixed price for attendees and aiding in budgeting for future event participation. Event passes may be purchased for \$495 each and are valid for the duration of the Membership Period.

Definitions

Project Member

A project is any research funded initiative from any country where the project pays the OGF membership fee rather than the individual partner in the project paying the fees. Projects of a duration of more than 24 months will be asked to renew the amount based on the duration of the project.

Chartered Groups

These groups are officially chartered with OGF and are involved in activity designed to fulfill their charter. This activity typically includes regularly organized meetings at each OGF event, and regular phone calls outside the remit of the physical OGF events.
